### *Snow Removal*

The District of Tumbler Ridge would like to remind everyone that since the SNOW has come there should be NO VEHICLES left on any Roadway to interfere with the proper removal of SNOW from the streets and sidewalks. We can authorize the towing of vehicles that are in the way of snow removal but would prefer that the owner takes the initiative themselves.

The clearing of snow and ice from sidewalks bordering properties, commercial and residential, must also be removed within 24 hours of the accumulation.

We would also ask that you NOT put snow from your property back onto the roadways, the operations crew is trying to keep the roads open and free from snow but it would seem that several residents are blowing or pushing the snow from their driveways back onto the roadways. This is a violation of the District's Traffic and Highways Regulations Bylaw # 454, 2002 and a fine may be issued.

The District of Tumbler Ridge wishes everybody the Best of the Season and asks for your cooperation in dealing with our snow accumulations.

### *Solid Waste Collection*

The District of Tumbler Ridge would like to remind all residents to make sure their garbage containers have tight fitting lids to eliminate the possibility of animals spreading the contents. The collector does not have the time to pick-up garbage that is spread about and may not pick-up garbage that is left out in bags only. We ask that you take precautions in how you put your solid waste out for pick-up.
